Gordon is open to a project and he would like to attend a site visit to the area. Before I left on this assignment I was checking our environmental records to find out what resource analysis had been done already. When I get back I plan to sketch out a map of a proposed project area and schedule a site visit with Gordon and members of the FSC."
